We wish to announce the International Scientific Conference "The Influence of European Integration on the Development of Monetary Law", which will be held at the Faculty of Law, University of Niš, on the 30th and 31st of May 2023 as an online event. The central Conference day for paper presentation will be 30th May 2023.

If we carefully look at events in international monetary relations in the last decade, we can notice a new wave of European monetary law, more intense, richer, and more complex than all the other events on the previous global monetary scene. New tendencies are not only characterized by the primacy of soft law over primary monetary solutions, new jurisdictions of international judicial instances for resolving monetary and fiscal disputes, new central bank powers, and the evolution of the concept of monetary sovereignty, but also in making more "human approaches" in implementation monetary law. In the condition of technological revolutions, environmental crises, and pandemics shocks, EU monetary legislation requires some modification of the central bank mandate and monetary-fiscal coordination mechanism. In light of these challenges, we welcome all theoretical and empirical papers that cut dealing with (**but are not limited to**):

- Challenges of European monetary and economic integration;
- A new model of economic governance in a time of crisis;
- Implementation of Banking and Fiscal Union concept in *EMU*;

- Challenges of monetary and fiscal Integration of South East European Countries and Western Balkans.
